1. Title of the practice: COVID-19 AWARENESS PROGRAMME

2. The context

As we all know pandemic is an epidemic of an infectious disease that spreads all over the world and creates havoc. Since the COVID 19 spread in 2019 in China and its reach all over the world has brought everybody under the shadow of one more pandemic and millions of people have been losing their lives these days. In many countries two to four waves have created chaos and compelled people and governments to lock everything down for months together. On 27th January 2020, the first case of COVID 19 was reported in Kerala; since then, we have seen that almost everything got affected by this pandemic. Recently India has come out of the third wave of novel corona virus and has been trying level best to bring back the regularity in everything. After the third wave, we have been trying to come back to a new normal but still there is threat which has created havoc. This scenario compelled us to think positively about the psychological support which was desperately needed for the people in the pandemic. Hence we undertook this as a challenge and decided to create awareness about COVID-19 Pandemic and helped needy people to survive during 1st lockdown period.

3. Objectives of the practice

- Understanding the impact of COVID-19 pandemic and try to help needy people during pandemic
- Creating awareness among the students, staff and people in general about COVID-19 pandemic

4. The Practice

COVID-19 AWARENESS PROGRAMME was the need of the situation. Following activities and events were conducted during the lockdowns imposed during the COVID-19 Pandemic.

- Our NSS unit conducted online quiz of COVID-19 awareness from 27th April 2020 to 7 th May 2020, where every individual got knowledge about the myths and reality of COVID-19 and after attempting the awareness quiz successfully participants got e-certificate of appreciation. Total 418 people participated in this online COVID-19 awareness quiz.

- Our students prepared e-posters and videos which contains information of basic precautionary measures to be undertaken to avoid infection and spread of COVID -19 to aware people in society. Instead of frightening the people were encouraged to wash their hands regularly, avoid gatherings and maintain at least 1 meter distance during interaction.
- Considering the seriousness of pandemic situation every individual's basic need is face mask, sanitizers to prevent themselves from infection of COVID-19, keeping this thing in mind our NSS volunteers distributed total 1136 masks to the needy people in their nearby areas.
- This sudden pandemic situation affected economic condition of several people. So our NSS unit decided to help those needy people in this pandemic situation by distributing some amount of grocery. Our NSS unit distributed grocery to the total 100 needy families from NSS adopted village Parmachi. Also NSS unit distributed grocery to the total 15 Adivasi families which are lives near college campus.

5. Evidence of Success

All the events for COVID-19 AWARENESS PROGRAMME conducted successfully. 1136 people benefited with mask, 115 families benefited with grocery also as much as possible people aware with basic precautionary measures of COVID -19 through quiz, e-posters and videos.
